Weighted Grading Policy

It is the policy of the Garrett High School Board of Education that honors and college dual credit courses will receive weighted grades for the purposes of calculating and determining class rank as well as class valedictorian and salutatorian.

Counselors will translate the grades of a transfer student into our weighted grade system.

Weighted grades will be limited to:

- Courses that are clearly academic and college-preparatory in nature.
- Advanced courses in the areas of English, mathematics, and sciences, and to upper level courses in other subject areas that may be required for admission to certain colleges.
