

I.C.E. Scholarship Criteria

Any student can be eligible for a scholarship from I.C.E. at the time of completion of his/her academic career from Garrett-Keyser-Butler Schools based upon the following criteria:

This scholarship is open to all seniors graduating from Garrett High School that have successfully completed at least one semester of the I.C.E. program. Students removed from the program, for any reason, are not eligible.

Required forms include:

- * GHS Cover Page & Scholarship Application Form
- * Cover Letter explaining how the student benefitted from the I.C.E. program at GHS, plans after graduation, and why the student should be selected for the scholarship.

Selection process:

A committee of teachers and/or community leaders involved with the I.C.E. program will determine final allocation of the I.C.E. Scholarship(s).
