GARRETT'S ALPHA CHI CHAPTER AWARDS A \$500 SCHOLARSHIP TO A GARRETT HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATING SENIOR WITH PLANS TO CONTINUE HIS/HER EDUCATION IN NURSING OR THE MEDICAL FIELD.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THE APPLICANT MUST BE A GARRETT HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATING SENIOR.**
- 2. THE APPLICANT MUST HAVE A MINIMUM GRADE POINT AVERAGE OF 5.0 ON A 12.0 SCALE AFTER SEVEN (7) SEMESTERS.**
- 3. THE APPLICANT MUST ENROLL IN A FOUR-YEAR COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY WITH THE GOAL OF ATTAINING A BACHELORS DEGREE.**
- 4. IF AWARDED THE SCHOLARSHIP, IT MUST BE USED THE SCHOOL YEAR IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION.**
